Learning and Living the Bible Together Romans 6:15 - 7:13

Review of Romans 1:1-6:14

- 1. We are to proclaim the Gospel.
- 2. Sin separates all of us from God.
- 3. The only solution is salvation given by God's grace through faith.
- 4. We have victory in Jesus!

In Romans 6-8, we are reminded to live in victory over sin. Although we have these promises in Scripture, it seems many Christians live in defeat and discouragement. Why?

- Acceptance of sin within our lives and within the church and a failure to see it's horror
- Poor examples of devoted Christians around us
- Poor teaching of Scripture
- Weak discipline in our lives; i.e., failing to be in His Word and in a daily relationship with Him
- False security; i.e., thinking we are saved but not saved
- Temptation is all around us and sin seems inevitable

Lesson on Romans 6:15-7:13

- 1. A Christian is not <u>free to sin</u>. We are saved by grace but that is not a license to sin. (6:1,15)
 - a) No one can expect victory if they have a soft attitude toward sin.
- 2. We are all slaves to something. To whom are you a slave? (6:16-19)
 - a) We now have a <u>new loyalty</u> and cannot ignore our new master.
- 3. Salvation from God brings permanent, life changing results. (6:16-23)
 - a) Your mold has been set <u>differently</u>. You are made new and on a new path. (v.17)
 - b) Your <u>heart</u> is changed and is aimed toward Him. There should now be hunger for Him and His Word. (v.17)
 - c) The Christian life is a <u>transformed</u> life and is not characterized by a habitually, long term sinful lifestyle. (1 John 1:6, 2:4, 3:9-10; Col. 1:21-22; 2 Cor. 5:17)

- d) God is at work in you to <u>sanctify</u> you and make you more like Jesus. (v. 22; 8:29)
- e) Jesus is the <u>only way</u> to salvation and life. True living is not in false religion or works of our flesh. (v.23)
- 4. A Christian has been given victory over sin by Christ. (6:15-7:6)
 - a) <u>Understand</u> what you have given in Christ.
 - b) Recognize your victory is in Jesus and <u>yield</u> to Him. <u>Submit</u> to Him. Present yourselves to Him [willing choice to obey] (v.19)
 - c) <u>See</u> what your life is to be in Him. You are to have a new life producing <u>fruit</u>. (7:4-5)
 - See your purpose and it is the way to fulfillment
 - d) A Christian is saved to be enslaved to Him but it is the best path for your life.
 - e) A Christian is not free to pursue their <u>lusts</u>. You are free from sin and it's condemnation. You are now a bondslave to Him and His righteousness. (vv.19-22)

BUT THEIR IS A **WATCHOUT**. WE WANT TO SUBSTITUTE RELIGION FOR AUTHENTIC CHRISTIAN LIVING.

- 5. You cannot live the Christian life in your flesh by substituting rules and <u>religion</u> for a relationship with Christ. You are now wed to Jesus! Learn about Hlm. Live for Him. (7:1-13)
 - a) <u>Seek God</u> through His Word. Learn about His character. Love Him and obedience will follow.

My Response: (Not you working just harder. It is reliance on HIm and relationship with Him)

- Pray for righteousness and a hatred for sin.
- **-** Examine self. Repent, respond to Him.
- Rejoice in the victory you have in Jesus. Thank Him for newness of life.
- Live in subjection to Christ. Lay aside former sin. Pursue Him as Lord. Rely on Him.
- Let Jesus produce fruit through you.
