# Romans 15 & 16 Paul's Farewell

#### > Romans 15:14-33 — Characteristics in Paul's life we should have in our life:

- 1. We should encourage fellow Christians in their walk. (v. 14)
  - encouragement includes both affirmation and counsel
- 2. We should be faithful to the grace given to us. (v. 15-16)
  - we have been <u>called</u>, providentially placed, and <u>given</u> spiritual gifts for use in His kingdom
- 3. We should be <u>burdened</u> to present the Gospel to all. (vv. 16, 19, 20-21)
  - sacrifice so others can hear (1400 miles from Jerusalem to Illyricum)
  - have a heart for those who have never heard
  - live Romans 1:16
- 4. We should be God focused and not self centered. (vv. 17-18)
  - proclaim and boast about Him and do not seek self glory or praise
- 5. We should serve, trusting in God's providential hand. (v. 22)
  - willing to go anywhere but submitting to His direction
- 6. We should have <u>love</u> for Christian brothers and sisters, even those we have not met. (vv. 22-24, 32-33)
- 7. We should be willing to <u>sacrifice</u> for others, be willing to ask others to sacrifice to help fellow Christians, and focus on building unity in the body of Christ. (vv. 25-27)
  - give to brothers and sisters in need around the world
- 8. We should <u>not be content</u> based on our past service to Christ but go forward in service to Him accompanied by planning to do more for Him. (vv. 24,28)
  - we should plan and act this year on doing more in service to Him
- 9. We should be people of <u>prayer</u> realizing we cannot serve without His power. (v. 30)
  - pray with <u>diligence and a burden</u> for the Gospel to advance
- 10. We should <u>pursue</u> the will of God and <u>yield</u> ourselves with our time, resources, and energy. (15:14-33)
  - dependent upon the Holy Spirit to lead us (vv. 16, 19, 29-30)
  - walking in love

#### > Romans 16 — Final Words

- 1. We should lovingly <u>receive</u> one another in Christ, offer our help to them as they come to us, and commend them for their Kingdom work. (16:1-2)
- 2. Christian brothers and sisters are to have genuine love for one another in Christ. (16:3-16; 21-24)
  - We should know each other by name and know of their work in the Kingdom.
  - We should <u>encourage</u> each other by <u>commending</u> one another in their work in the Kingdom.
    - \* we encourage all, even the less visible and lesser known
  - We should <u>publicly encourage</u> others and not seek glory for ourselves.
  - We should love one another by <u>unselfishly giving</u> of ourselves to work beside them in Kingdom work.
    - \* to the point of risking our lives for one another (v.4)
  - We should have <u>genuine warmth</u> and tenderness for one another. And our Godly affection for one another should be evident to others. (v. 16)
  - God's Kingdom is diverse. So should our fellowship be.
  - We should seek to <u>foster</u> a <u>family feeling</u> and <u>community</u> within the church body.
     (vv. 21-24)
  - We should work together to build His Kingdom and do His work.

## 3. We must be careful to <u>guard</u> ourselves and the local church against false doctrine. (16:17-20)

- Work to bring unity and peace within the local church.
- Be on guard by <u>using the Word</u> as your source of wisdom. People can deceive with smooth or flattering speech.
- Walk in obedience to Him.
- Realize the devil will always be attacking. But be encouraged. God wins!

#### 4. We should walk in praise to God for His work. (16:25-27)

- God is <u>able</u> to save.
- God is able to establish us only because of the work of Christ.
  - \* we are stable and secure in Him because of the work of Christ.
- God has <u>planned</u> and has <u>prophesied</u> of salvation before and throughout time.
- God offers salvation to every nation.
- God, our source of all wisdom, is worthy of all of our praise, adoration, and worship.
