## Learning and Living the Bible Together Romans 9

- 1. Paul's <u>CARE</u> and passion for the people of Israel. (vv. 1-3)
  - -> we should have a SINCERE & CONTINUAL BURDEN for the lost
- 2. God's <u>COVENANT</u> with Israel. (vv. 4-5)
- 3. Paul addresses the <u>CONCERNS</u> that Israel and others might have about God. (vv. 6-33)
  - a) Is God faithful to keep His promises? (v. 6)
    - God is <u>FAITHFUL</u> and <u>RELIABLE</u>. He keeps His promises. (vv. 6-9)
    - God is <u>PURPOSEFUL</u>. (vv. 10-13)
    - God is SOVEREIGN. He does what He pleases. (vv. 10-13)
    - God works through whom He CHOOSES. (vv. 10-13)
  - b) Is God just? Is God fair? (v.14)
    - Justice says all are <u>CONDEMNED</u> due to our sin. (Rom. 3:1-20; John 3:17-19,36)
    - God is <u>MERCIFUL</u> and <u>COMPASSIONATE</u> but sometimes we can fail to see it. (vv. 15-16)
    - God is <u>SOVEREIGN</u>, <u>RIGHTEOUS</u>, and <u>POWERFUL</u>. He <u>WORKS</u> perfectly way to accomplish His will. (vv. 16-18)
      - \* for our GOOD and His GLORY
      - \* sometimes MISUNDERSTOOD by us
  - c) Is God righteous? Is it right for God to judge me if He is in control? My destiny is not my fault. (v.19)

NOTE: Paul visits this again in chapter 10 but first mentions God and who He is.

- God is THE AUTHORITY. He is the Boss of all things, including us. (vv. 20-24)
- God is <u>CREATOR</u>. Who are we to questions Him? (vv. 20-21)
- God is <u>SOVEREIGN</u>. This is a key message throughout this text. (vv. 20-24)
- God is NOT SURPRISED and knows exactly what He is doing. (vv. 25-30)

- God <u>FULFILLS</u> His Word and is always <u>FAITHFUL</u> to keep His promises. (vv. 25-30)
- -> We must <u>SUBMIT</u> to His sovereignty.
- -> God <u>CALLS PEOPLE</u> to Him. He has called Jews and Gentiles. God does the saving.
  - \* Christians should have <u>JOY AND GRATITUDE</u> over His grace and say "why me?"
  - \* Christians should have <u>SECURITY</u> in knowing our salvation is solely in Him and through Him.
  - \* Christians should be in <u>AWE</u> of God. He is way beyond our understanding and to be worshiped.
- -> We should take great <u>COMFORT</u> on seeing God and His attributes. He is perfectly in control of all.
- d) Did God's Word to Israel fail? No! (9:30-33)
  - GENTILES are included in His extension of grace.
  - God saves (9:6-29) but <u>RIGHTEOUSNESS</u> is required to be saved. (9:30-33)
  - Righteousness for salvation comes by FAITH. (9:30)
  - Israel made the <u>MISTAKE</u> that many make today they pursued righteousness based upon works and not by faith in Christ. (9:31-33)
- -> People are all sinners destined for hell but <u>SOME</u> are saved by <u>GRACE</u> through <u>FAITH</u>. (vv. 30-33; also see10:1-4)

## Our Response

- \* Christians should <u>SHARE THE GOSPEL</u> with great passion. Sovereignty and election are mentioned but we must share the Gospel with passion. We must serve with a burdened heart and bruised knees [J. D. Greear] (9:1-3; see also 10:1)
- \* People need to be shown that righteousness is not achieved via <u>RELIGIOUS</u> activity. (10:2-3)
- \* People need to <u>KNOW AND LEARN</u> about the true God. We must tell them about God and His solution for them.
