## Learning and Living the Bible Together Living the Christian Life #1

What does it mean to live as a Christian? The Bible shows me people that are passionate for God (David, Abraham, Joseph, Daniel, Paul, Peter, John, etc.). How can I live for Him like that? I want to live the life for which God made me.

The First Question to ask is whether you are a true follower of Christ. You cannot live the Christian life unless you are converted by Christ.

- 1. What does Scripture say about a Christian's conversion and their redeemed life?
  - a) a Christian is a <u>new creation</u> when they are saved (2 Cor. 5:15,17)
    - their <u>desire</u> is to <u>live</u> for Him. Your desire is for the things of God.
  - b) a Christian is born again into a new life and a new person (John 3:3)
    - their life is to be different from their old life (Rom. 6:4, 8:11; Gal. 2:20)
      - \* repentance has occurred in their heart (Rom. 10:9-10; 2 Peter 3:9; Acts 17:30)
      - \* Sin is not comfortable.
    - they are made new for a life of good works for Him (Eph. 2:8-10)
  - c) a Christian can have an abundant life in Christ (John 10:10)
    - they can have joy and peace in their daily life (Phil. 4:4-7)
  - d) a Christian has been <u>set apart</u> for Him and for <u>use</u> in His kingdom (1 Peter 2:9-10; 2 Cor. 5:18-20)
  - e) a Christian has the Holy Spirit at <u>work</u> within them, convicting them and shaping them into the image of Christ (Rom. 8:29; Phil. 1:6; John16:13-14; Phil. 2:13)
  - f) a person can be <u>deceived</u> (Titus 1:16; Matt. 7:21-23) How? Religious activity can be substituted for Him.
    - a person can think they are <u>secure</u> and think they are a Christian but they are not
    - a person can rely on <u>religious activity</u> (baptism, church membership, praying a prayer [but no change]) but have never been truly converted

- professing Christians should examine themselves (2 Cor. 13:5)
  - \* Review Rom. 3:23, 6:23, 5:8, 10:9-10, 10:13; Eph. 2:8-9. Scripture reveals the way to salvation.
  - \* Followers of Christ know they were <u>delivered</u> from spiritual death. They see their sin, their complete inability to be good enough to go to heaven, and realize they are eternally lost without the work of Jesus. (Eph. 2:1-3)
  - \* Followers of Christ have been made alive only due to <u>God's mercy, love,</u> and grace. (Eph. 2:4-7)
- —> A Christian is made <u>new</u> by Christ. There should be <u>real change</u> occurring in the life of a follower of Christ. True living starts with a new birth only caused by God. We must be careful not to substitute baptism, religious activity, church membership, or respect from others for real salvation.
- -> A Christian should <u>pursue</u> the life they have been made for in Christ (Phill. 1:21; Mark 12:30; 2 Cor. 4:16-5:9; Phil. 2:12)
  - Followers of Christ <u>hunger</u> for God and the things of God (Phil. 3:10-11; John 14:21)

We have a Great Salvation! To live the Christian Life, we must first make sure we are truly saved and made new by Him.
