## A. The Character of Job (vv. 1-10)

- 1. His Fear (v.1)
  - he was a man that feared God, that pursued God, that wanted to please God
- 2. His Family (v.2)
- 3. His Fortune (v.3)
  - he was wealthy!
- 4. His Fame (v.3)
  - everyone knew who Job was. He was a man of prominence.
- 5. His Faithfulness (vv. 4-5)
- 6. His Favor (v.10)
  - God protected Job and blessed Job
- B. The Conversation with God and the devil (vv. 6-12)
  - 1. God's Authority (v. 6)
    - He is THE BOSS. All appear before Him and He is the one in charge.
  - 2. God's Awareness (v. 8)
    - He was aware of everything about Job.
  - 3. God's Allowance (v. 12)
    - He allowed Job to be attacked by the devil, with restrictions.

- 4. The devil's Inability (v. 10)
  - The devil can only do what he is allowed to do
- 5. The devil's Intent (v. 9-10)
  - He scorns us. He wants to destroy us. He is pure evil.
- C. The <u>Catastrophes</u> in Job's life (vv. 13-19)
  - Catastrophic events that happened virtually all at once
- D. The Commitment shown by Job (vv. 20-22)
  - 1. His sorrow (v.20)
  - 2. His surrender (vv. 20-22)

## **Application to us:**

- 1. God works in ways that we do not fully understand but He knows exactly what He is doing.
- 2. God sees what we do and knows our character. (Prov. 5:21)
- 3. The devil knows those who are faithful and stands ready to attack.
- 4. The Lord gives and takes away according to His will.
- 5. In good times or bad, we are to be loyal to Him. We are not to blame God.
- 6. The devil is real but he is defeated. He can only do what he is allowed to do.
- 7. God may not offer immediate relief to our pain or sorrow.
- 8. Life is short. Commit to serve Him even if you have nothing on this earth. Look to the future.
